**Description/Remarks**

This is a 1-story, 2-bay domestic building in the Bungalow/craftsman style built in 1925. The structural system is frame. The foundation is piers. Exterior walls are original wood siding. The building has a cross gable roof clad in replacement asphalt shingles with open cornice , gable brackets. Windows are original wood, 1/1 double-hung sashes. There is a single-story, full-span open porch characterized by a gabled roof clad in asphalt shingles with square wood posts on square concrete block piers.
