Description/Remarks

This is a 1-story, 3-bay domestic building in the Craftsman style built in 1920. The structural system is balloon frame. The foundation is undetermined. Exterior walls are original brick and original wood siding. The building has a cross gable roof clad in replacement asphalt shingles with box cornice. Windows are replacement aluminum, 1/1 double-hung sashes. There is a single-story, two-bay open porch characterized by a gabled roof clad in asphalt shingles with square brick posts.
