Description/Remarks

This is a 1.5-story, 3-bay domestic building in the Colonial Revival style with Craftsman influences built in 1920. The structural system is balloon frame. The foundation is undetermined. Exterior walls are original brick and original wood siding. The building has a high side gable roof clad in original wood shingles with raked open cornice, exposed rafters and brackets and one shed-roofed dormer. There is one side left, exterior, brick chimney. Windows are original wood, 6/1 double-hung sashes. There is a single-story, full-span open porch characterized by an integrated (under the main) roof clad in wood shingles with square brick posts on square brick piers.
