Description/Remarks

This is a 2-story, 3-bay domestic building in the Prairie School style with Prairie School influences built in 1920. The structural system is balloon frame. The foundation is undetermined. Exterior walls are original brick. The building has a low hip roof clad in replacement asphalt shingles with box cornice and two hip-roofed dormers. There is one side left, exterior, brick chimney. Windows are original wood, 9/1 double-hung sashes. There is a single-bay central veranda characterized by a flat with balcony roof clad in an undetermined material with rectangular paired brick posts.
