Description/Remarks

This is a 2-story, 2-bay domestic building in the Craftsman style built in 1924. The structural system is frame. The foundation is piers. Exterior walls are original brick and original stucco. The building has a cross gable roof clad in pressed/patterned metal with box cornice. Windows are original wood, vertical 4/1 double-hung sashes. There is a three-quarter open porch characterized by a gabled roof clad in pressed/patterned metal on square brick piers.
