**Description/Remarks**

This is a 1.5-story, 3-bay domestic building in the Folk/Traditional style with Craftsman influences built in 1908. The structural system is balloon frame. The foundation is undetermined. Exterior walls are original wood siding and original wood siding. The building has a hip and gable roof clad in replacement asphalt shingles with box cornice and multiple clipped gable dormers. There are two offset left chimneys. Windows are replacement aluminum, 1/1 double-hung sashes. There is a single-story, two-bay open porch characterized by a shed roof clad in asphalt shingles on classical wood piers. Half of front porch was enclosed for additional living space.
