Description/Remarks

This is a 1.5-story, 6-bay domestic building in the Eastlake/Folk Victorian style with Folk/Traditional influences built ca. 1908. The structural system is balloon frame. The foundation is undetermined. Exterior walls are original wood siding and original wood siding. The building has a bellcast hip roof clad in replacement asphalt shingles with box cornice and one bellcast hipped dormer. There is one center, straddle ridge, brick chimney. Windows are original wood, Vertical 6-light casements. There is a single-story, full-span open porch characterized by an integrated (under the main) roof with paired wood posts.
