Description/Remarks

This is a 1.5-story, 3-bay domestic building in the Folk/Traditional style with Bungalow/craftsman influences built in 1928. The structural system is balloon frame. The foundation is undetermined. Exterior walls are original wood siding and original wood siding. The building has a pyramidal roof clad in replacement asphalt shingles and one hip-roofed dormer. Windows are original wood, 12/1 double-hung sashes. There is a single-story, single-bay umbrage characterized by an integrated (under the main) roof.
