Description/Remarks

This is a 1.5-story, 4-bay domestic building in the English Cottage Revival style with Tudor influences built in 1928. The structural system is balloon frame. The foundation is undetermined. Exterior walls are original brick. The building has a high side gable roof clad in replacement asphalt shingles with box cornice. There is one off center in front, exterior, brick chimney. Windows are replacement vinyl, Prairie style grid/1 double-hung sashes. There is a platform/stoop.
