**Description/Remarks**

This is a 1-story, 4-bay domestic building in the Colonial Revival style with Classical Revival influences built in 1921. The structural system is balloon frame. The foundation is undetermined. Exterior walls are original wood paneling. The building has a bellcast hip roof clad in replacement asphalt shingles with box cornice and one gabled dormer. There are one offset left, front slope, brick chimney and two offset right, side slope, brick chimneys. Windows are original wood, multi/multi double-hung sashes. There is a single-story, single-bay open porch characterized by a bellcast gable roof clad in asphalt shingles with classical wood posts on square brick piers.
