Description/Remarks

This is a 2-story, 4-bay domestic building in the Georgian style built in 1916. The structural system is balloon frame. The foundation is undetermined. Exterior walls are original wood siding. The building has a medium side gable roof clad in replacement asphalt shingles with box cornice. There is one side left, exterior, brick chimney. Windows are original wood, multi/1 double-hung sashes. There is a platform/stoop characterized by a gabled roof.
