Description/Remarks

This is a 1.5-story, 3-bay domestic building in the Craftsman style built in 1928. The structural system is balloon frame. The foundation is undetermined. Exterior walls are original wood siding. The building has a low hip roof clad in replacement asphalt shingles with box cornice and one hip-roofed dormer. Windows are replacement aluminum, 1/1 double-hung sashes. There is a single-story, full-span open porch characterized by an integrated (under the main) roof clad in asphalt shingles with square wood posts on square wood piers.
