**Description/Remarks**

This is a 1-story, 4-bay domestic building in the No Primary Style built in 1940. The structural system is frame. The foundation is undetermined. Exterior walls are original stone. The building has a medium side gable roof clad in replacement asphalt shingles with flush eaves. Windows are original wood, 1/1 double-hung sashes. There is a single-story, single-bay veranda characterized by a flat roof clad in an undetermined material with modern decorative metal posts.
