Description/Remarks

This site is a designed landscape built in 1933. VACANT Part of the original Bankhead Highway Route through Abilene. Now part of the airport. Not publicly accessible. The Bankhead Highway Historic District is a linear district consisting of four discontinuous sections in Taylor County, Texas. Each section includes slightly less than one mile that date from c. 1927-1929, as well as related structures and objects. The district is identified as Sections A, B, C, beginning at the western boundary of Taylor County and ending at the city limits of Abilene, and Section D, on the eastern edge of Abilene along the northern end of the Abilene airport
