**Description/Remarks**

This is a 2-story, 5-bay domestic building in the Craftsman style built in c. 1920. The structural system is balloon frame. The foundation is undetermined. Exterior walls are original asbestos. The building has a low hip roof clad in replacement asphalt shingles with box cornice. Windows are original wood, 4/1 double-hung sashes. There is a single-story, corner wrap-around open porch characterized by a hip roof clad in asphalt shingles with short battered wood posts on square brick piers.
