**Description/Remarks**

This is a 1-story, 3-bay domestic building in the Folk/Traditional style with Craftsman influences built in 1920. The structural system is balloon frame. The foundation is piers. Exterior walls are original wood siding. The building has a low hip roof clad in replacement asphalt shingles with box cornice. Windows are , 1/1 double-hung sashes. There is a single-story, full-span veranda characterized by an integrated (under the main) roof clad in asphalt shingles with round wood posts on square brick piers.
