**Description/Remarks**

This is a 2-story, 3-bay domestic building in the Prairie School style built in 1926. The structural system is balloon frame. The foundation is undetermined. Exterior walls are original brick. The building has a low hip roof clad in replacement asphalt shingles with raked box cornice , paired brackets and one hip-roofed dormer. Windows are replacement aluminum, 1/1 double-hung sashes. There is an open porch characterized by a hip roof clad in asphalt shingles with square paired brick posts.
