Description/Remarks

This is a 2-story, 5-bay domestic building in the Prairie School style with Colonial Revival influences built in 1927. The structural system is undetermined. The foundation is undetermined. Exterior walls are original brick. The building has a medium hip roof clad in replacement asphalt shingles with box cornice and one hip-roofed dormer. Windows are original wood, 4/1 double-hung sashes. There is a single-story, corner wrap-around open porch characterized by a hip roof clad in asphalt shingles with short battered brick posts on square brick piers.
