Description/Remarks

This is a 2-story, 3-bay domestic building in the Tudor style with English Cottage Revival influences built in 1941. The structural system is balloon frame. The foundation is undetermined. Exterior walls are original brick and original half timbering. The building has a cross gable roof clad in replacement asphalt shingles. There is one off center in front, exterior, brick chimney. Windows are replacement aluminum, 1/1 double-hung sashes. There is a recessed corner open porch characterized by an integrated (under the main) roof with arched brick posts.
