Description/Remarks

This is a 2-story, 4-bay domestic building in the Prairie School style built in 1930. The structural system is undetermined. The foundation is undetermined. Exterior walls are original brick. The building has a medium hip roof clad in replacement asphalt shingles with box cornice , brackets. There is one side right, exterior, brick chimney. Windows are original wood, 9/1 double-hung sashes. There is a full-span open porch characterized by a hip roof clad in asphalt shingles with paired brick posts on square brick piers. Porte Cochere filled in for 2 car garage in 1990s.
