Description/Remarks

This is a 1-story, 4-bay domestic building in the Craftsman style built in 1930. The structural system is undetermined. The foundation is undetermined. Exterior walls are original brick. The building has a cross gable roof clad in replacement asphalt shingles with open cornice , exposed rafters and brackets. Windows are original wood, Chicago/1 multipane casements. There is a single-story, three-quarter open porch characterized by a gabled roof clad in asphalt shingles with square brick posts.
