**Description/Remarks**

This is a 1.5-story, 5-bay domestic building in the Craftsman style built in 1929. The structural system is undetermined. The foundation is undetermined. Exterior walls are original brick veneer and original wood siding. The building has a cross gable roof clad in replacement asphalt shingles. Windows are replacement vinyl, Prairie style grid/1 grouped dh sash. There is a single-story, corner wrap-around open porch characterized by a gabled roof clad in asphalt shingles with battered wood posts on square brick piers.
