Description/Remarks

This is a 2-story, 4-bay domestic building in the English Cottage Revival style with Colonial Revival influences built in 1930. The structural system is undetermined. Exterior walls are original brick veneer and original stucco. The building has a gambrel roof clad in original wood shingles. There is one off center in front, exterior, brick chimney. Windows are original wood, 6/6 double-hung sashes. There is a single-story, single-bay platform/stoop characterized by a gable with arch roof with turned wood posts.
