Description/Remarks

This is a 1-story, 1-bay domestic building in the Folk/Traditional style with Craftsman influences built in 1926. The structural system is undetermined. The foundation is piers. Exterior walls are original wood siding. The building has a medium front gable roof clad in replacement asphalt shingles , exposed rafters. Windows are original wood, 1/1 double-hung sashes. There is a single-bay open porch characterized by a gabled roof clad in asphalt shingles with short battered wood posts on square stuccoed piers.
