### Description/Remarks

This is a 1-story, 3-bay domestic building in the Folk/Traditional style with Late Victorian influences built in 1905. The structural system is undetermined. The foundation is undetermined. Exterior walls are original weatherboard. The building has a hip and gable roof clad in replacement asphalt shingles. There is a single-story, two-bay open porch characterized by a shed roof clad in asphalt shingles with square wood posts. Minor alterations include window and door replacement, the front gable window was changed into an entry way some time after 1990.
