Description/Remarks

This is a 1.5-story, 3-bay domestic building in the Folk/Traditional style with Late Victorian influences built in 1905. The structural system is undetermined. The foundation is piers. Exterior walls are original wood siding. The building has a hipped gable roof clad in replacement asphalt shingles. There is a single-story, single-bay open porch characterized by a shed roof clad in asphalt shingles with square wood posts.
