Description/Remarks

This is a 2-story, 3-bay domestic building in the Late Victorian style with Greek Revival influences built in 1905. The structural system is undetermined. Exterior walls are original wood siding. The building has a low hip roof clad in replacement asphalt shingles. Windows are original wood, multi/1 double-hung sashes. There is a full-span open porch characterized by a hip roof clad in asphalt shingles with square wood posts.
