Description/Remarks

This is a 1.5-story, 4-bay domestic building in the Queen Anne style with Colonial Revival influences built in 1906. The structural system is undetermined. Exterior walls are original wood siding. The building has a multi-plane/complex roof clad in original rubberized/asphalt composite. Windows are original wood, 1/1 double-hung sashes. There is a single-story, three-bay open porch characterized by a shed roof clad in rubberized/asphalt composite with turned wood posts.
