**Description/Remarks**

This is a 2.5-story, 2-bay domestic building in the Eastlake/Folk Victorian style with Late Victorian influences built in 1909. The structural system is undetermined. Exterior walls are original wood siding. The building has a multi-plane cross gable roof clad in original wood shingles with box cornice , decorative bargeboard. Windows are original wood, 1/1 grouped dh sash. There is a single-story, full-span open porch characterized by a hip roof clad in wood shingles with turned wood posts.
