This is a 1-story, 5-bay domestic building in the Folk/Traditional style with Late Victorian influences built in 1915. The structural system is undetermined. Exterior walls are original wood siding. The building has a high hip roof clad in replacement asphalt shingles. Windows are original wood, multi-light double-hung sashes. There is a single-story, three-bay open porch characterized by a shed roof clad in asphalt shingles with round posts.
