Description/Remarks

This is a 1.5-story, 4-bay domestic building in the Tudor style with English Cottage Revival influences built in 1926. The structural system is undetermined. The foundation is undetermined. Exterior walls are original brick and original half timbering. The building has a bellcast gable roof clad in replacement asphalt shingles and multiple bellcast gabled dormers. Windows are original wood, multi/multi grouped dh sash. Tudor Revival with Arched doorway, decoative brick work, multiple paned windows that include double hung sashes, grouped casement windows and an eyebrow window on the front facade.
