Description/Remarks

This is a 2-story, 3-bay domestic building in the Georgian style with Colonial Revival influences built in 1925. The structural system is undetermined. The foundation is undetermined. Exterior walls are original brick veneer. The building has a low hip roof clad in replacement asphalt shingles. Windows are replacement aluminum, 1/1 double-hung sashes. There is a single-story, single-bay platform/stoop characterized by a flat roof clad in an undetermined material with classical wood posts. Colonial Revival Georgian with a Prairie School roof.
