Description/Remarks

This is a 1.5-story, 3-bay domestic building in the Craftsman style built in 1927. The structural system is undetermined. The foundation is undetermined. Exterior walls are original brick. The building has a medium hip roof clad in replacement asphalt shingles. There is one offset left, front slope, brick chimney. Windows are original wood, Prairie style grid/1 double-hung sashes. There is a single-story, full-span open porch characterized by an integrated (under the main) roof clad in asphalt shingles with short battered brick posts on square brick piers.
