Description/Remarks

This is a 3-story, 10-bay commercial building in the Exotic Revival style with Gothic/Neo-Gothic influences built in 1890. The structural system is wood platform. The foundation is undetermined. Exterior walls are original brick and original brick. The building has a flat with parapet roof. Windows are original wood, 1/1 double-hung sashes. The building was listed as a non-contributing structure in the 1992 National Register nomination form for the Abilene Commercial Historic District. Subsequently, the false façade that wrapped around the ground floor was removed, exposing the original façade. Today, the building would most likely be listed as a contributing structure to the Abilene Commercial Historic National Register District.
