Description/Remarks

This is a 2-story, 3-bay domestic building in the Prairie School style with Colonial Revival influences built in 1920. The structural system is undetermined. The foundation is undetermined. Exterior walls are original wood siding. The building has a low hip roof clad in replacement asphalt shingles. Windows are original wood, 1/1 double-hung sashes. There is a single-story, two-bay open porch characterized by a hip roof clad in asphalt shingles with classical wood posts.
