Description/Remarks

This is a 2-story, 4-bay domestic building in the Colonial Revival style with Craftsman influences built in 1930. The structural system is undetermined. Exterior walls are original brick veneer. The building has a medium side gable roof clad in replacement asphalt shingles. Windows are original wood, vertical 3/1 double-hung sashes. There is a single-bay open porch characterized by a gabled roof clad in asphalt shingles with square brick posts.
