Description/Remarks

This is a 1-story, 4-bay domestic building in the Tudor style with English Cottage Revival influences built in 1929. The structural system is frame. The foundation is undetermined. Exterior walls are original brick and original stucco. The building has a cross gable roof clad in replacement asphalt shingles with box cornice. There is one off center in front, exterior, brick chimney. Windows are original wood, 1/1 double-hung sashes. There is a single-story, recessed corner open porch characterized by an integrated (under the main) roof with square brick posts.
