**Description/Remarks**

This is a 1.5-story, 4-bay domestic building in the Mission/Spanish Revival style built in 1929. The structural system is frame. The foundation is undetermined. Exterior walls are original stucco. The building has a flat with parapet roof with flush eaves. There is one side right, exterior, stuccoed chimney. Windows are original wood, 4/1 double-hung sashes. There is a two-story, single-bay enclosed porch characterized by a tower roof clad in terra-cotta tiles with arched stuccoed posts.
