Description/Remarks

This is a 1.5-story, 3-bay domestic building in the Eastlake/Queen Anne style built in 1884. The structural system is frame. The foundation is undetermined. Exterior walls are original wood siding. The building has a multi-plane front gable roof clad in replacement asphalt shingles with box cornice and one gabled dormer. There is one offset left, front slope, brick chimney. Windows are original wood, 1/1 double-hung sashes. There is a wrap-around open porch characterized by a shed roof clad in asphalt shingles with classical wood posts. Gable Dormer with small balcony on front. Underwent repairs in 2012 due to a fire.
