**Description/Remarks**

This is a 1.5-story, 3-bay domestic building in the Eastlake/Queen Anne style built in 1905. The structural system is frame. The foundation is piers. Exterior walls are original wood siding. The building has a multi-plane/complex roof clad in replacement asphalt shingles with box cornice and one gabled dormer. Windows are original wood, 1/1 double-hung sashes. There is a single-story, wrap-around open porch characterized by an integrated (under the main) roof clad in asphalt shingles with round wood posts.
