**Description/Remarks**

This is a 2-story, 4-bay domestic building in the Mission/Spanish Revival style built in 1928. The structural system is frame. Exterior walls are original brick veneer. The building has a high hip roof clad in original terra cotta barrel tile. There are one offset left, side slope, brick chimney and two offset right, side slope, brick chimneys. Windows are original wood, 9/9 double-hung sashes. There is a single-story, single-bay platform/stoop characterized by a flat roof with classical wood posts. Very large rear addition is not visible from street.
