**Description/Remarks**

This is a 1-story, multiple-bay domestic building in the Classical Revival style with English Cottage Revival influences built in 1955. The structural system is frame. Exterior walls are original brick. The building has a multi-plane/complex roof clad in original wood shingles with flush eaves. There is one off center in front, exterior, brick chimney. Windows are original wood, multi-light double-hung sashes. Rambling ranch with irregular massing.
