Description/Remarks

This is a 1.5-story, 3-bay domestic building in the Colonial Revival style with English Cottage Revival influences built in 1921. The structural system is frame. The foundation is undetermined. Exterior walls are original wood siding. The building has a bellcast gambrel roof clad in replacement asphalt shingles with flush eaves and one shed-roofed dormer. Windows are original wood, 6/6 double-hung sashes. There is a two-bay open porch characterized by an integrated (under the main) roof with short battered wood posts on square brick piers.
