**Description/Remarks**

This is a 2-story, 3-bay domestic building in the Late Victorian style with Greek Revival influences built in 1907. The structural system is frame. The foundation is undetermined. Exterior walls are original wood siding. The building has a hip and gable roof clad in replacement asphalt shingles with box cornice. Windows are original wood, 1/1 double-hung sashes. There is a single-story, single-bay open porch characterized by a flat with balcony roof with classical wood posts.
