Description/Remarks

This is a 2-story, 4-bay domestic building in the Craftsman style built in 1920. The structural system is frame. The foundation is undetermined. Exterior walls are original wood siding. The building has a multi-plane front gable roof clad in replacement asphalt shingles with raked open cornice, exposed rafters and brackets and two gabled dormers. There is a single-story, three-quarter open porch characterized by a gabled roof clad in asphalt shingles with short battered wood posts on square brick piers.
