**Description/Remarks**

This is a 1.5-story, 3-bay domestic building in the Folk/Traditional style with Eastlake/Queen Anne influences built in 1895. The structural system is frame. The foundation is piers. Exterior walls are original wood siding. The building has a hipped gable roof clad in replacement asphalt shingles. Windows are original wood, 1/1 double-hung sashes. There is a single-story, full-span open porch characterized by a hip-and-gable roof clad in asphalt shingles with paired wood posts.
