**Description/Remarks**

This is a 1-story, 3-bay domestic building in the Craftsman style built in 1915. The structural system is frame. The foundation is piers. Exterior walls are original brick veneer and original wood siding. The building has a multi-plane front gable roof clad in replacement asphalt shingles with box cornice , gable peak brackets. Windows are original wood, vertical 5/1 double-hung sashes. There is a single-story, three-quarter open porch characterized by a gabled roof clad in asphalt shingles with short battered wood posts on square brick piers.
