**Description/Remarks**

This is a 1-story, 4-bay domestic building in the Eclectic style with Craftsman influences built in 1929. The structural system is frame. The foundation is undetermined. Exterior walls are original stone and original wood siding. The building has a hip and gable roof clad in replacement asphalt shingles with box cornice. There is one off center in front, exterior, brick chimney. Windows are original wood double-hung sashes. There is a single-story, two-bay open porch characterized by a gabled roof clad in asphalt shingles with arched brick posts.
