Description/Remarks

This is a 1-story, 5-bay domestic building in the Mission/Spanish Revival style with Eclectic influences built in 1925. The structural system is frame. The foundation is undetermined. Exterior walls are original stucco. The building has a flat with parapet roof. There is a single-story, single-bay portico characterized by a flat roof with arched stuccoed posts. Terra Cotta Barrel tile on shed awnings over the windows.
