Description/Remarks

This is a 1-story, 3-bay domestic building in the Craftsman style built in 1925. The structural system is frame. The foundation is undetermined. Exterior walls are original brick and replacement vinyl siding. The building has a multi-plane front gable roof clad in replacement asphalt shingles with open cornice , exposed rafters. Windows are original wood, vertical 4/1 double-hung sashes. There is a single-story, two-bay open porch characterized by a gabled roof clad in asphalt shingles with square brick posts.
